

"Mosaicum"
Bracelet

Materials for a 17 cm (6¾") Bracelet :

- 38 Arcos® par Puca®- Paris, Collection Enamel Turquoise
- 64 Volos® par Puca®- Paris, Full Azzuro
- 32 Piros® par Puca®- Paris, Dark Blue Pearl
- Miyuki 15/0 Seed Beads (SB15), Turquoise mat
- Flexible beading needle
- FireLine 0.12 mm
- Clasp of your choice



1) Place a stop bead on approximately 80 cm (32") of thread.

String the following sequence through the center hole of the beads :

1 Arcos, 2 SB15, 1 Volos, 2 SB15, 1 Arcos
2 SB15, 1 Volos, 2 SB15.

Repeat this sequence 4 times.

Tie the work into a circle with a few knots.

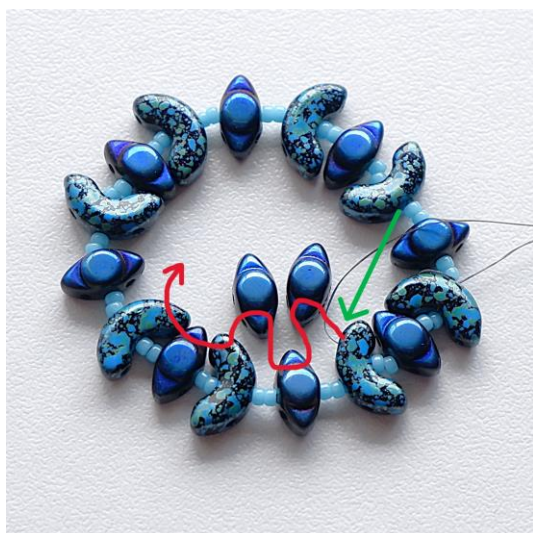
2) Work inside the circle.

Pass through the upper hole of an Arcos, then through the Volos and the Arcos indicated by the green arrow.

Place 2 Volos in the center of the circle.

Weave in a zigzag path through the lower hole of the first Volos, then through the upper hole of the Volos from step 1, and finally through the lower hole of the second Volos.

Move into position at the red arrow and continue all around the circle.





3) Here is the result.

Pass through the lower hole of the next Volos, then move up through the center hole indicated by the arrow.

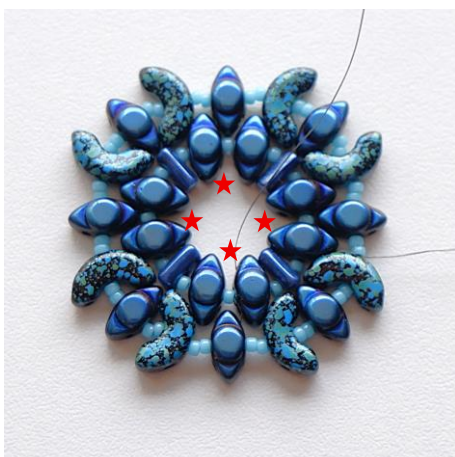


4) Add 1 SB15, 1 Piros (lower hole), 1 SB15, then pass through the center hole of the next Volos.

Add another 1 SB15 and pass through the center hole of the following Volos.

Continue all around.

Move into the upper hole of a Volos located between the two center Volos, as indicated by the green arrow.



5) Add 1 Piros (lower hole) in each position marked with a red star, between the two Volos (upper hole).

Pass through the upper holes of the next Piros and Volos, then add another Piros in the same way.

Repeat until 4 Piros have been added.



6) Here is the result.

Pass through the upper hole of one of the Piros added in the previous step and add 2 SB15 between each Piros.

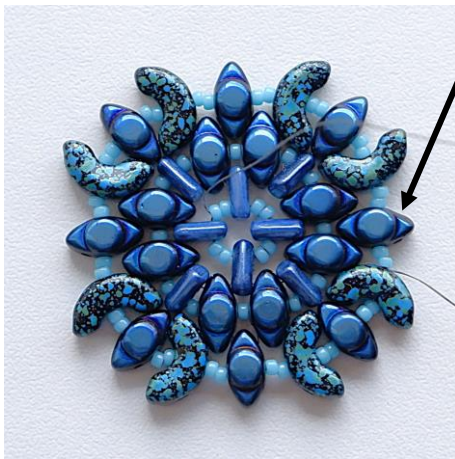
Reinforce the work by passing through the seed beads again as many times as necessary.

Leave the remaining thread from each module, as it will be used later to join all the modules together.

7) Here is the result.

Make 3 more modules to obtain a 17 cm (6¾") bracelet.

Move into the position indicated by the arrow to prepare for assembly.



8) Joining the modules :

After the Volos indicated by the green arrow, insert :

- 2 SB15
- 1 Arcos (left hole)
- 5 SB15, then pass through the right hole of the Arcos
- 2 SB15, then pass through the left hole of the Volos on the second module.

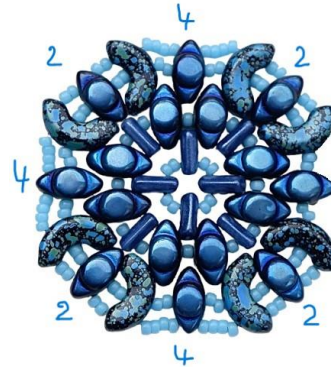
Repeat the same steps in mirror image using a second Arcos.





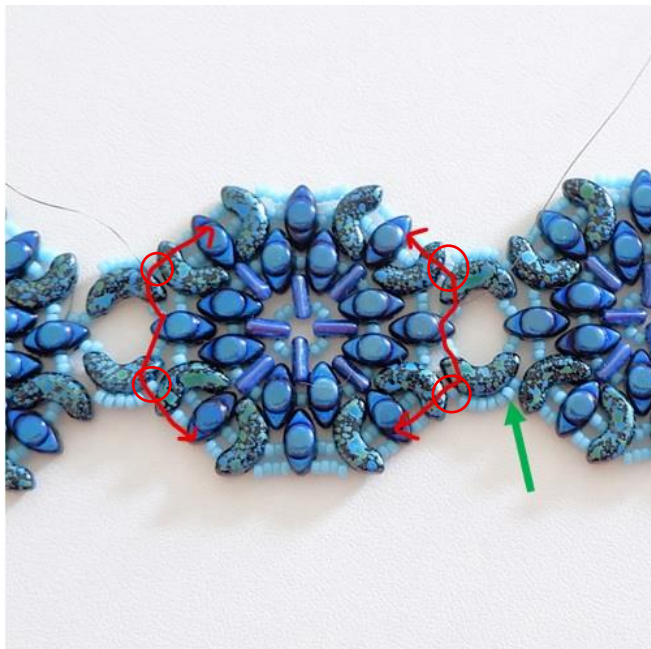
9) Reinforce the join by passing once more through all the beads added in the previous step.

Move into position HERE and begin adding SB15 around the outer edge, working to the left.



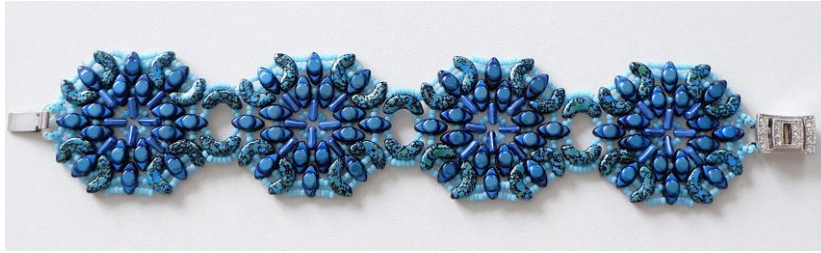
10) Now use the four thread tails that were left for assembly.

While joining the modules and working around the outer edge, also complete the following steps :



- Reinforce the joins between the modules and the connecting bridges by adding 1 SB15 where indicated by the red signals.
- Weave all thread tails through the beadwork, following the most suitable thread path.
- Add a sixth SB15 above each Arcos on the connecting bridges, on either the right or left side as preferred, then pull the thread firmly (green arrow).

Attach the clasp of your choice.



Your "Mosaicum" bracelet is now complete.

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
