"Scarlett"
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ARCOS® PAR PUCA® - PARIS
ENAMEL TURQUOISE

Materials for 1 earring:

- ARCOS ® PAR PUCA® - PARIS ENAMEL TURQUOISE (6 pcs)
- Rivoli 8 mm Saphire (1 pcs)
- Teardrop Faceted Bead Red (15*10 mm - 1 pcs)
- Fireline 4 lb (145 mm)
- Earring hook
- Miyuki Round Rocailles RR 15/0 Mint Green
- Miyuki Round Rocailles RR 15/0 Dyed Silver Lined Blue Zircon
- Miyuki Round Rocailles RR 15/0 Carnation Pink Ceylon
- Miyuki Round Rocailles RR 15/0 Galvanized Gold
- Miyuki Round Rocailles RR 11/0 Opaque Vermilion Red
- Miyuki Delica 11/0 Luminous Mermaid Green
- Toho Round 11/0 Galvanized Gold (Since Toho beads are slightly wider than Miyuki RR 11/0 beads, they were a better choice for this pattern, as they provide greater stability)



- The first step is form the crystal base from 24 Miyuki Delica beads.
- The method of making the base is the well-known peyote stitch. Work the first row with Miyuki Delica beads and the next 2 rows with Miyuki RR 15/0 beads (see photo 2).

- Go to the back of the crystal and work only with Miyuki RR 15/0 beads. It is preferable to cover the back of the crystal completely to avoid damaging it.

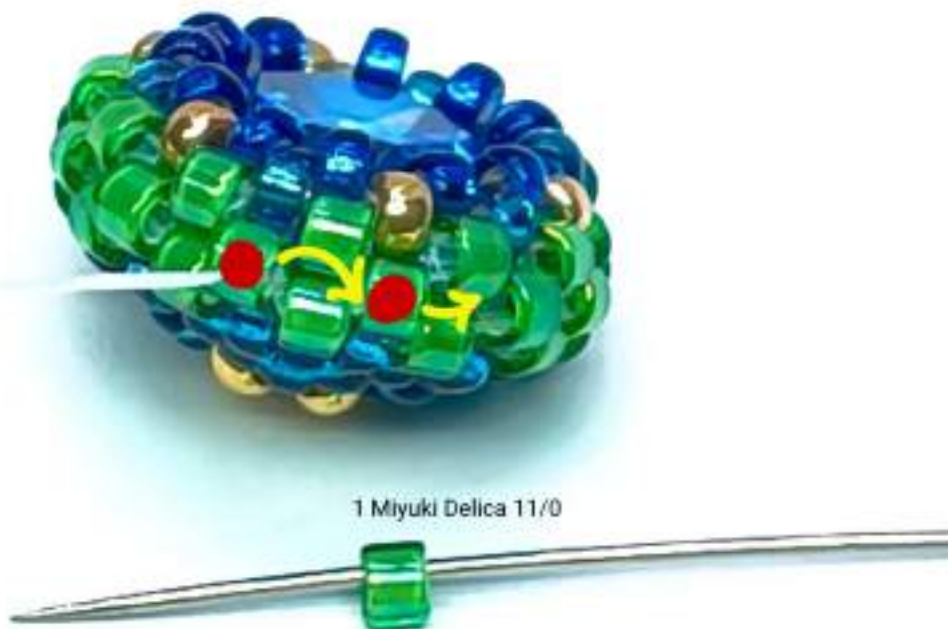

- Return to the front of the crystal. You will do the next steps on the side. See pictures 5 and 6!

- After adding the 2 Miyuki Delica 11/0 beads, insert the group of beads in picture 7 onto the needle. You will add this group of beads 3 times on the surface of the crystal.

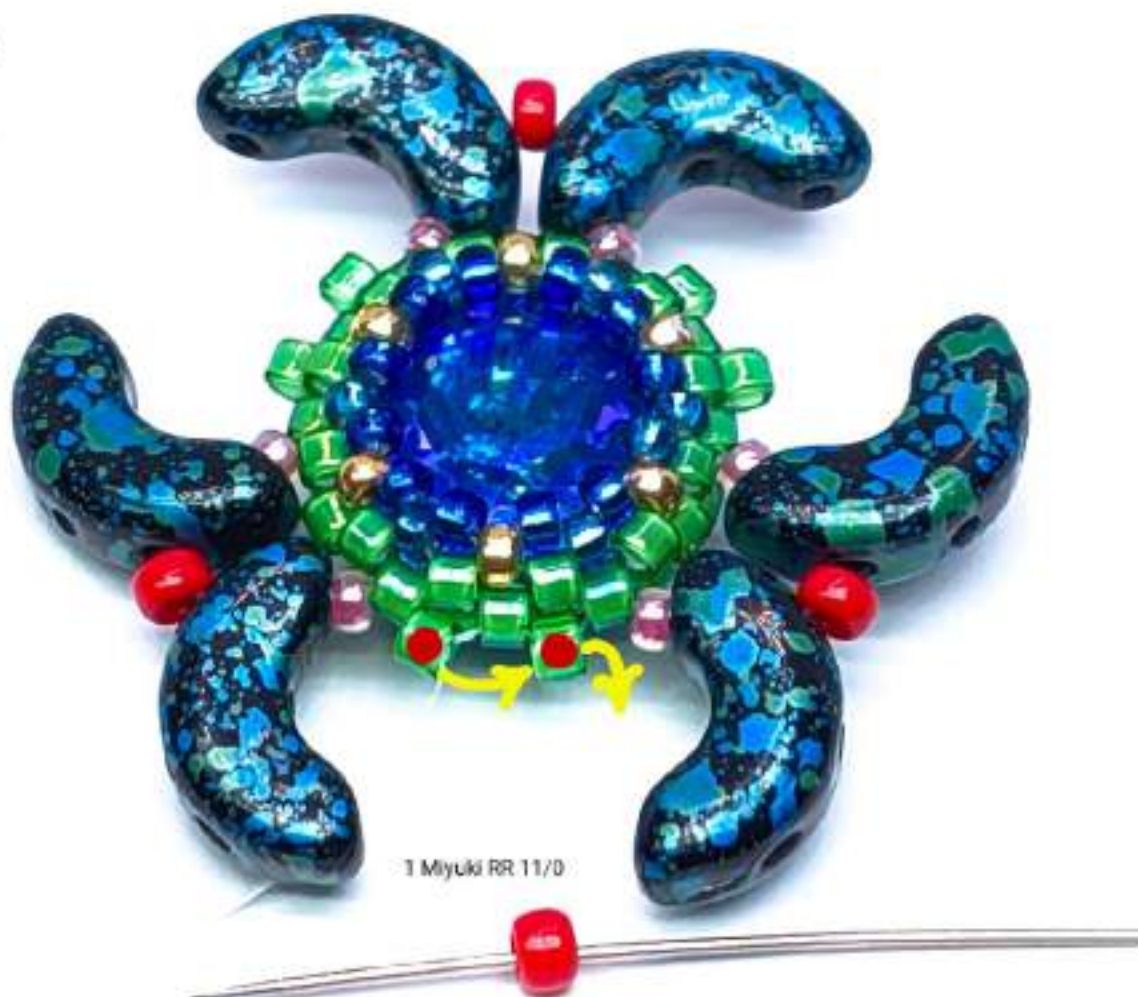

- After finishing the first row, you will return between the first Miyuki Delica 11/0 beads. There you will insert a red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead.

- Tie to the middle hole of the Arcos bead with 3 gold Miyuki RR 15/0 beads

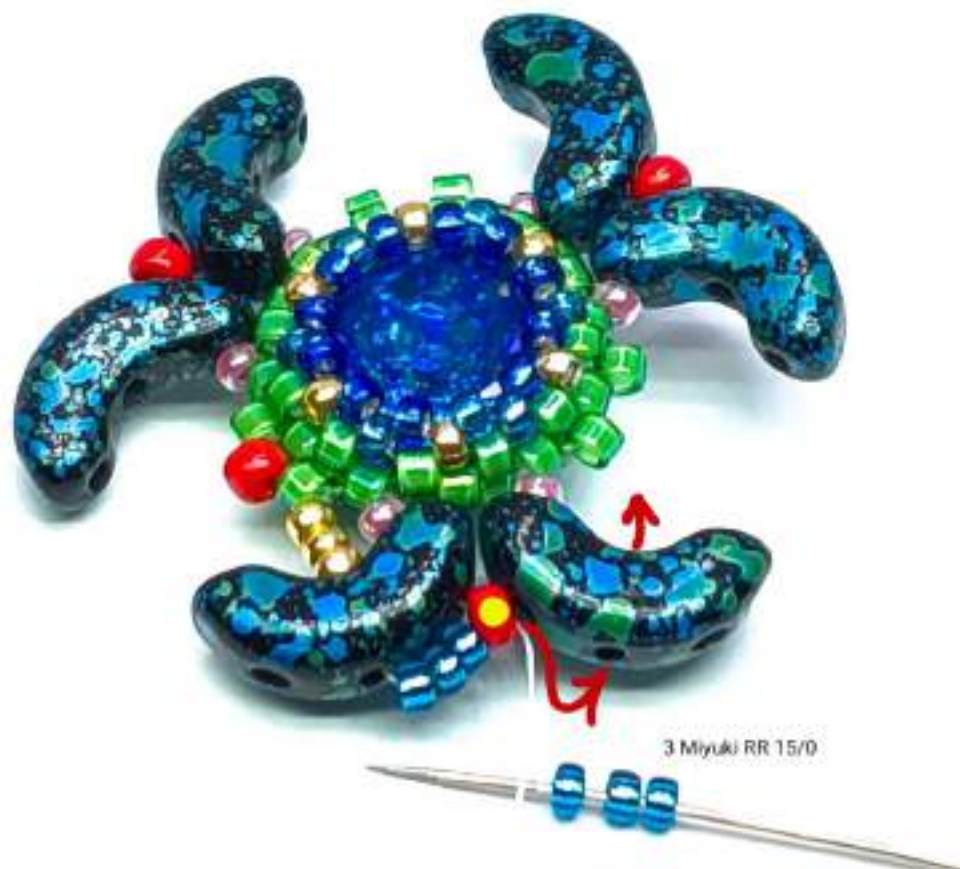

- Insert 3 gold Miyuki RR 15/0 beads onto the needle and connect the Arcos bead to the Miyuki Delica bead on the base of the crystal.

- Repeat the steps for all Arcos beads.
- You will finish working on this row when you reach the first inserted red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead.

- You will work this row just like the previous one. More precisely, you will connect each Arcos bead to the base using groups of 3 Miyuki RR 15/0 beads.

- After you have passed the needle through the top hole of the Arcos bead, insert 4 turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 onto the needle. Pass the needle through all the marked beads but skip the red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead.
- Place the beads and tighten the thread so that it is not visible above the red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead.

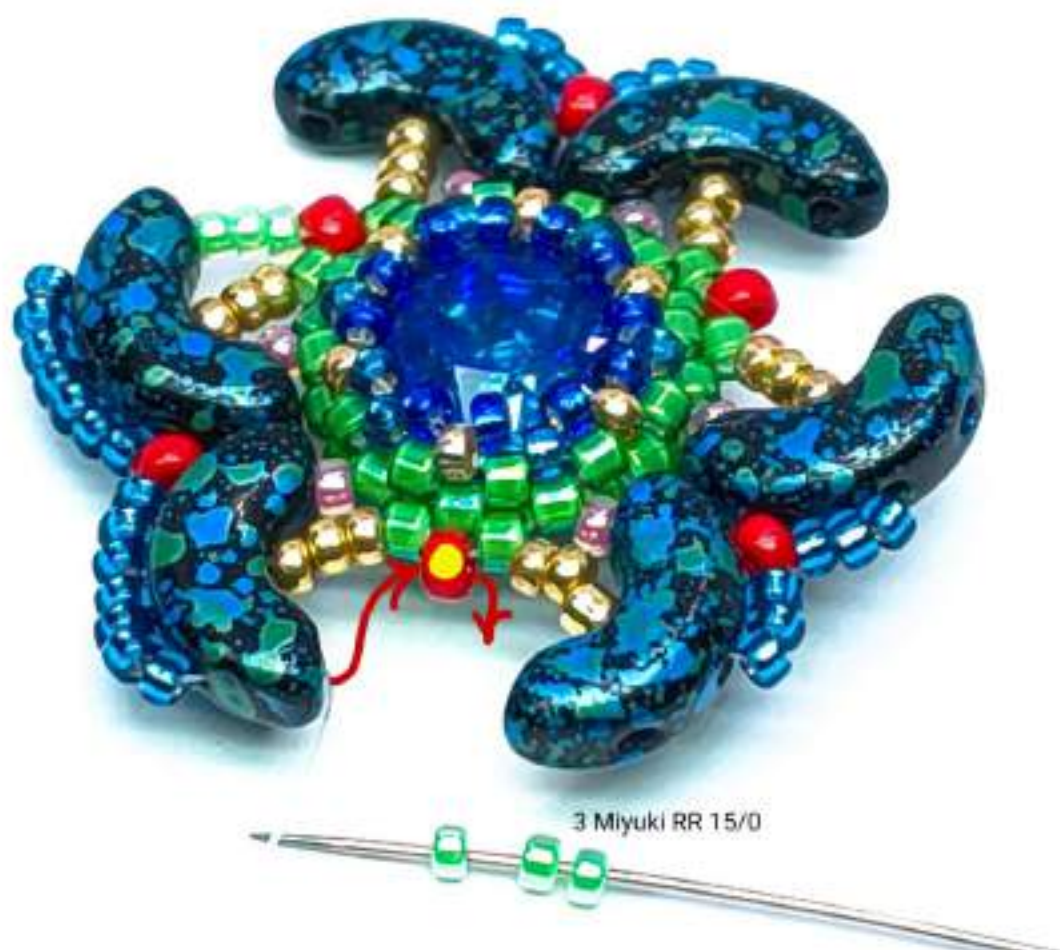
- After you have passed the needle through the marked row of beads, insert another 4 Miyuki RR 15/0 and enter the top hole of the Arcos bead. See the red arrow!

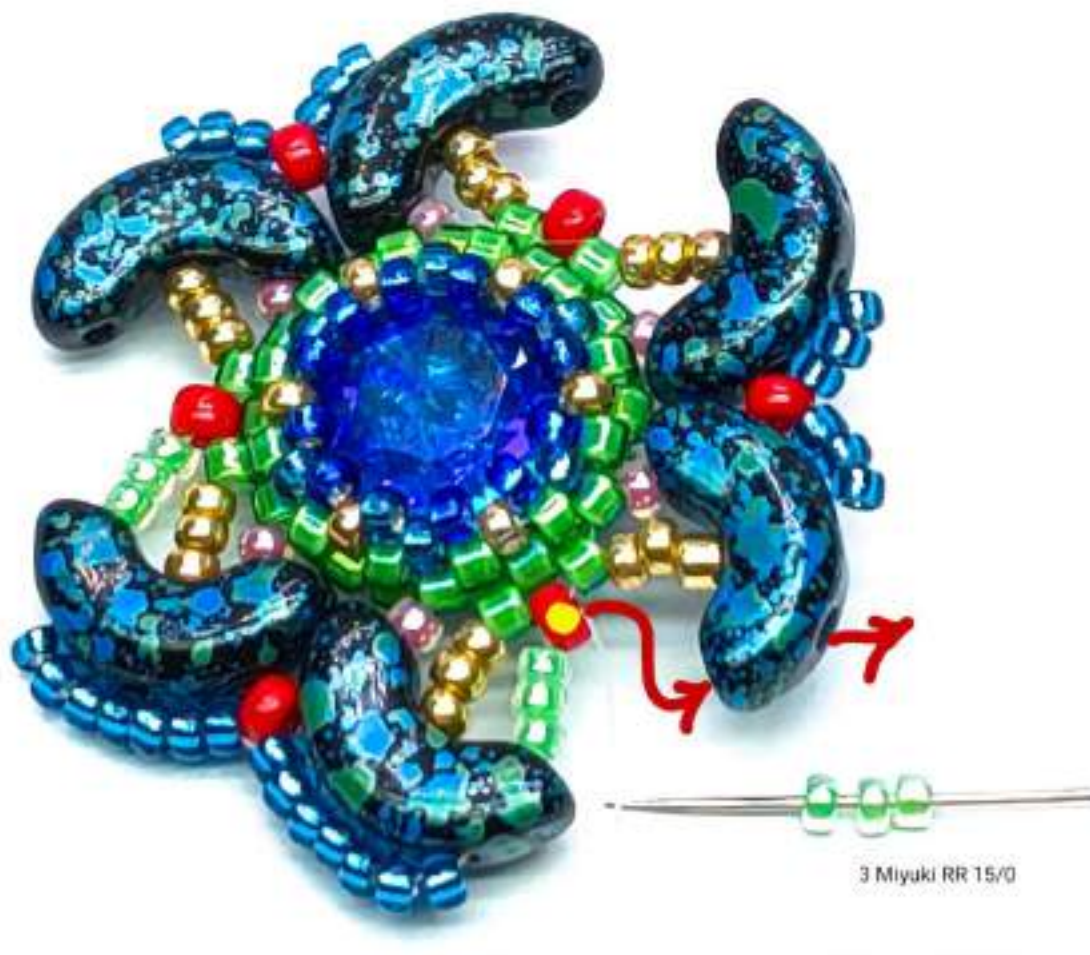


- Tie the red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead at the base with 3 green Miyuki RR 15/0 beads.

- After you have inserted the last 3 green Miyuki RR 15/0 beads, pass the needle through the red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead at the base and through the 3 marked Miyuki RR 15/0 beads.
- Exit the needle before the Arcos bead.

- Insert 1 gold Miyuki RR 15/0, 2 gold Toho Round 11/0 and 3 turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 onto the needle.
- Insert the needle into the marked beads covering the Arcos bead and exit the needle after the first 6 turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 beads.

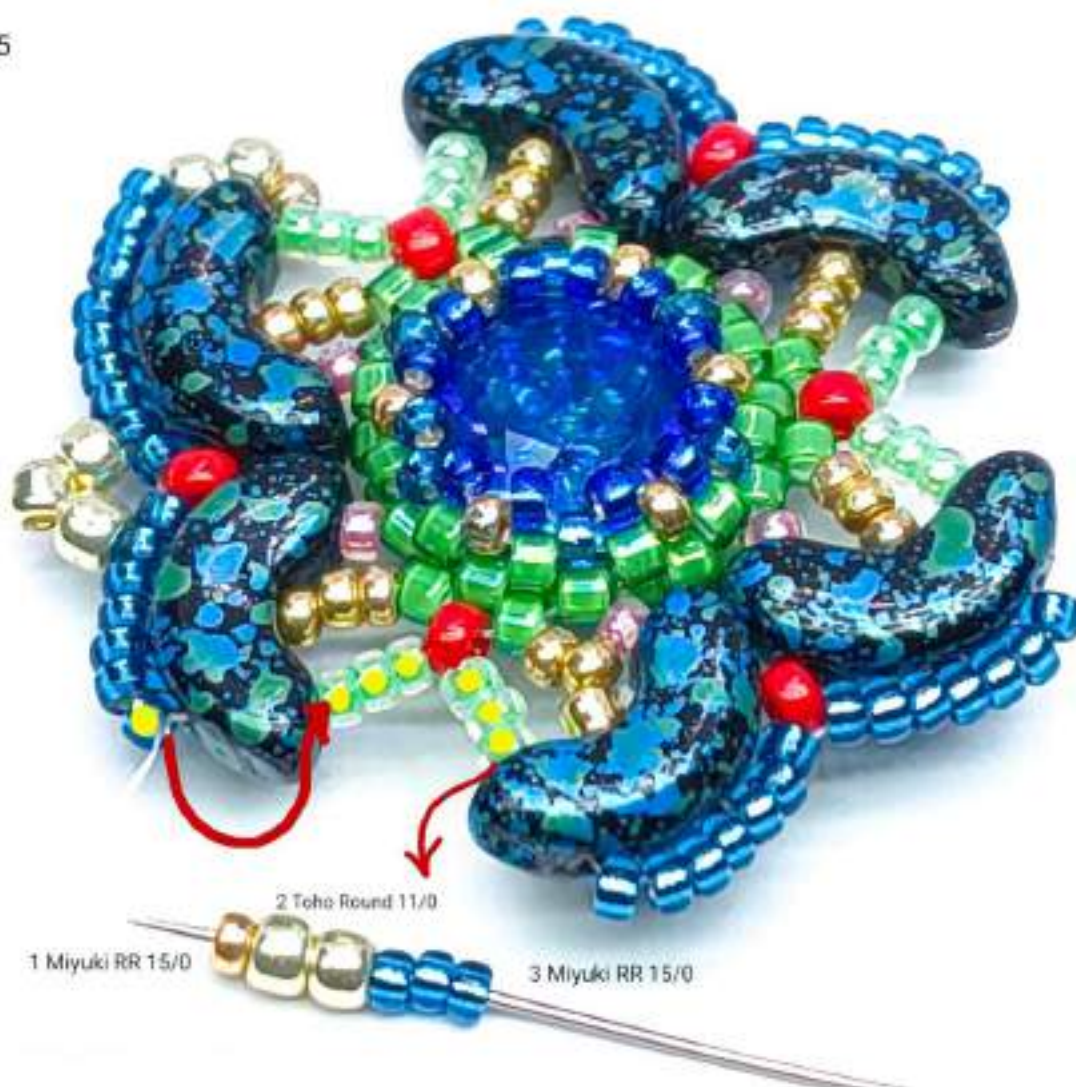
- Above the red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead, insert 3 gold Toho Round 11/0 beads.

- Insert the same group of beads on the needle but in reverse order: 3 Miyuki RR 15/0 turquoise, 2 Toho Round 11/0 gold and 1 Miyuki RR 15/0 gold.
- Pass the needle through all the marked green beads but skip the red Miyuki RR 11/0 bead at the bottom.

- Repeat the same steps for all Arcos beads. Be careful about the order of the beads on the needle.

- This will be where you will add the earring's hook, so you will only put in 2 Toho Round 11/0 beads.

- After you have finished covering all the Arcos beads, come out with the needle after the 2 Toho Round 11/0 beads that cover the first Arcos worked.
- Above the first Miyuki RR 15/0 you will add 3 green Miyuki RR 15/0 beads.

- Pass the needle through the next 3 Miyuki RR 15/0 turquoise beads. Exit above the 5th Miyuki RR 15/0 bead that covers the Arcos.

- Here you will insert 3 pink Miyuki RR 15/0 beads. Thread the next 3 turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 beads with the needle.

- Insert the needle through the Toho Round 11/0 beads and pass the needle through the 3 marked turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 beads. You will come out above the 5th Miyuki RR 15/0 bead on the Arcos.

3 Miyuki RR 15/0



- Insert 3 pink Miyuki RR 15/0 beads on top. Pass the needle through the next 3 marked turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 beads.
- Bring the needle out through the second-to-last turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 bead surrounding the Arcos bead.

- Insert 3 green Miyuki RR 15/0 beads on top of the last turquoise Miyuki RR 15/0 bead.
- Pass the needle between the 2 Toho Round 11/0 beads.

- Insert a Miyuki RR 15/0 pink bead between the 2 Toho Round 11/0 beads.

- String the Toho beads with 1 Miyuki RR 15/0 turquoise

33



- You have reached the next Arcos bead, between the 2 Toho Round beads. Here you will insert a new Miyuki RR 15/0 pink bead.

- Repeat the previous steps by adding the 2 groups of Miyuki RR 15/0 beads.
- Attach the earring hook as well.
- Continue working on the next 3 Arcos beads, adding groups of Miyuki RR 15/0 beads, green and pink.

- Attach the crystal drop.
