

Materiale: Bracelet 17 cm


- 32 Samos® par Puca®
- 64 Piros® par Puca®
- 32 Kalos® par Puca®
- 14 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- 1 Clasp of your choice
- Seed beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11) 2 colors
- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up 4 Samos



2) Close and exit HERE



3) Place between each Samos 1 R15 and exit HERE (second hole of Samos)



4) Pick up 1 Piros, 1 R15 and 1 Piros between Samos and exit HERE



5) Repeat step 4 the entire row and exit like picture



6) Pick up 2 R15 in the second hole of Piros



7) Pick up 1 R15, 1 Kalos, 1 R15 and exit like picture



8) Pick up 2 R15 through R15 HERE. Repeat steps 6 to 8. Do entire row like this



9) We obtain this Exit HERE like picture



10) Pick up 1 R11 between R15. Exit like picture from R15. Do entire row like this



11) We obtain this Exit through the R11
HERE. Repeat 7 times this element (step 1 to 9)



12) Connecting the elements with R11 and the three central R15



13) Pick up 1 R15 (red star) and exit like picture




14) Pick up 1 R15 (red star) and exit like picture from the other element (R15). Repeat steps 12 to 14 for all the elements



15) We obtain this 😊



16) Exit HERE through the R15



17) Pick up 1 R11 and exit through the R15 after Piros



18) Pick up 2 R15 through the second hole of Kalos



19) Pick up 1 R11 between Kalos



20) Pick up 2 R15 through R15, the Piros and R15 HERE. Repeat steps 17 to 20 all the row (all sides of the bracelet)



21) We obtain this 😊



22) Exit HERE through the two R15 and insert 1 R15, 1 B4,1 R15 through the two R15. Do entire row like this. End your thread



23) Place the clasp with R11 and consolidate



24) Your bracelet Lady Queen is finished 😊

I wish you a happy beading. I offer you this pattern.
