

## Tutorial Pin Cushion « Soleil » © par PUCA®

## Material :

- 17 Arcos<sup>®</sup> par Puca<sup>®</sup>
- 34 Kalos<sup>®</sup> par Puca
- 18 Piros<sup>®</sup> par Puca<sup>®</sup>
- 1 wooden base James par Puca<sup>®</sup>
- 17 round beads 3mm (PR3)
- 1 metal circle 30 mm
- Seed beads 15/0, (R15) 11/0 (R11)
- 1 round fabric 6 cm Ø + stuffing
- Optional Paint for the base, glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up 34 Kalos and 34 R15 alternately and close. Exit through bottom hole of Kalos



2) Between each Kalos, pick up 1 R11 and exit through R11



3) Pick up 1 Arcos, 7 R15 , pass through Arcos and exit through 2nd R11.Repeat for the length of the pattern





5) Between each seed beads, pick up 1 PR3. Repeat for the length of the pattern. Close your work



6) Glue your work on the wooden base, at the bottom


## Second part :



7) Make a knot in your circle




10) Pick up 1 R11, 1 Piros, pass under the circle



8) Pick up 1 Piros, 3 R15, pass through Piros and pass under the circle



11) Then pass over the circle and through Piros



9) Pass over the circle and through Piros



12) Repeat steps until you have used a total of 18 Piros



13) You'll now have this 🐵 Close your work



14) Cut a 6cm circle of fabric, run a gathering thread around the edge, and tighten around the stuffing



15) You'll now have this ② Cut off excess fabric



16) Glue the cushion on the base



17) Glue the circle in the base. Put a heavy book to flatten



18) Congratulations, you have finished your Pin cushion !
