Pearl 1 :



Material : For Pearl 1

- 13 Samos® par Puca®- Paris
- 13 Kalos® par Puca®- Paris
- 13 Piros® par Puca®- Paris
- 1 Support « Mini Juliette » ® par Puca®- Paris
- 13 Round Pearly Beads 3 mm ø (RPB)
- 1 Round Pearly Bead 4 mm ø (RPB4)
- 13 Round Beads 3 mm (RB3)
- 1 Acrylic Flowers 20 mm ø of your choice
- 1 Flower-shaped cup 8 mm ø
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15) + SB15 Color (SB15C) and 11/0 (SB11) + Color (SB11C)
- 1 Ball Headpin 7 mm
- 10 cm Chain
- 1 Cone-shaped Cap 6 mm
- Paint
- Fireline 0.12



1) Painting the support
Mini Juliette



2) Alternate 13 Samos
and 13 SB11 then close.
Exit HERE through the
second hole of Samos



3) Insert 1 SB11 between
each Samos.
Tighten !



4) Place the work on the support and exit through SB11 HERE



5) Insert 4 SB15 between each SB11



6) Here is the result 😊
Exit through 3rd SB15
HERE



7) Insert 1 SB11 between central 2 SB15.
All the way around 😊



8) Here is the result 😊
Exit through SB11 HERE



9) Insert 1 RB3 between each SB11



10) Here is the result 😊
Exit through SB11 HERE



11) Insert 1 SB15, 1 Kalos and 1 SB15 between each SB11



12) Here is the result 😊
Exit through SB15 HERE



13) Insert 1 SB11 through SB15, Kalos and SB15 HERE.

All the way around 😊



14) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the second hole of Kalos



15) Insert 1 SB11C between each Kalos. Exit through SB11C HERE



16) Insert 4 SB15 between each SB11C



17) Here is the result 😊
Exit through 3rd SB15



18) Insert 1 RPB through the central 2 SB15. All the way around 😊



19) Here is the result 😊
Exit through RPB HERE



20) Insert 1 SB11C between each RPB



21) Here is the result 😊
Exit through SB11C HERE



22) Insert 3 SB15 between each SB11C



23) Here is the result 😊
Exit through 2 SB15 HERE



24) Insert 1 Piros through the central SB15.
All the way around 😊



25) Exit through the bottom hole of Piros.
Insert 1 SB11C between each Piros



26) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the top hole of the Piros



27) Insert 1 SB15C between each Piros.
Exit through SB15



28) Insert 3 SB15 through the SB15C (above the Piros)



29) Exit through the 3rd SB15



30) Insert 2 SB15 through the SB15C.
Repeat steps 29 and 30 all the row



31) Here is the result 😊
Exit through central SB15



32) Insert the cap



33) Make a row of SB15,
Tighten well !
End your thread



34) Place the ball headpin
through the cap and pass
through the support



35) Place the acrylic
Flower, the Flower-
shaped cap and the RPB4
through the ball headpin



36) Make a nice little ring.
The pearl 1 is finished !



28) Here is the result 😊

Pearl 2 :



Material : For Pearl 2

- 12 Samos® par Puca®- Paris
- 6 Round Pearly Bead 3 mm ø (RPB3)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15) and 11/0 (SB11)
- 1 Cymbal (Pilos)
- Fireline 0.12



1) Alternate 6 Samos and 6 SB11.
Close on circle



2) Insert 3 SB15 between each side of Samos.
Exit through the three SB15 HERE



3) Insert 3 SB15, 1 SB11 and 3 SB15 above every Samos



4) Here is the result 😊
Exit through Samos HERE



5) Turn over your work



6) Alternate 6 SB11 and 6 Samos



7) Here is the result 😊



8) Repeat step 2 all the row. Exit through the three SB15 HERE



9) Insert 3 SB15 through the central SB11 of Samos below to assemble



10) Insert 3 SB15 and exit HERE through the three SB15. Repeat 5 times



11) For the last one, insert 2 SB15, 1 Pilos and 2 SB15 through the three SB15 HERE. Exit through central SB11



12) Reinforce with Pilos and SB11 HERE



13) Exit through the 3rd SB15 HERE



14) Insert the RPB3 in the 3 SB15 in front and exit HERE through 3 SB15 after the SB11. All the way around 😊



15) Here is the result 😊



16) Assembly 😊
Exit through the 3rd SB15,
pass through RPB3



17) Pass through the
three SB15, SB11 and
three SB15 as described
in the previous step



18) End your thread 😊

Pearl 3 :



Material : For Pearl 3

- 8 Lipsi® par Puca®- Paris
- 12 Acrylic Flowers 10 mm of your choice
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15) + (SB15C) and 11/0 (SB11)
- 1 Cymal (Pilos)
- 3 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- Fireline 0.12

Which explains the different color for this bag jewel «Isaée» ©



1) Alternate 4 Lipsi and
4 SB11



2) Close and exit through
SB11



3) Insert 1 SB11 through all
the SB11



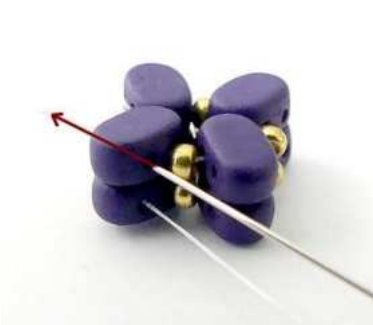
4) Here is the result 😊
Exit through SB11 HERE



5) Between each SB11,
insert 1 Lipsi (above each
Lipsi of the previous
step)



6) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the second
hole of Lipsi



7) Assemble 2 Lipsi one
on top of the other



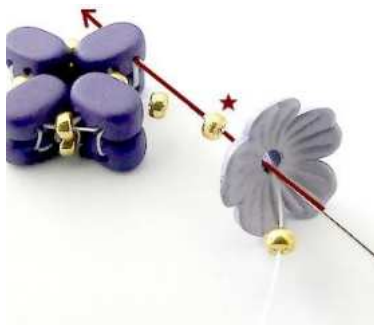
8) Repeat step 7 for the
four Lipsi



9) Here is the result 😊
Exit through Lipsi



10) Insert 1 SB11,
1 Flower and 1 SB11



11) Pass through the
Flower, add 1 SB11 and
exit through the Lipsi
HERE



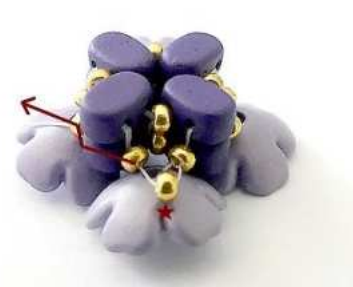
12) Here is the result 😊



13) Repeat steps 10 and 11 all the row



14) Turn over your work.
Exit through SB11 HERE



15) Insert 1 SB11 between SB11.
All the way around 😊



16) Exit HERE.
Repeat steps 10 to 16 on the other side of the work



17) Here is the result 😊



18) Exit through the three SB11 HERE



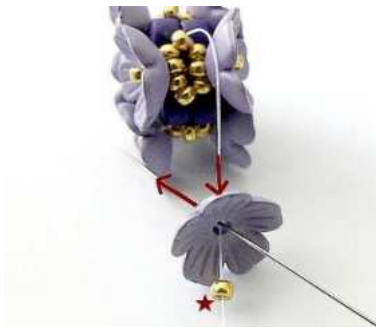
19) Insert 1 SB11 through the three SB11



20) Insert 1 SB11 through the three SB11 and exit through Lipsi and the next SB11.
Repeat steps 19 and 20 all the row



21) Here is the result 😊
Exit through SB11 HERE



22) Insert 1 Flower and 1 SB11



23) Pass through the Flower and SB11 HERE



24) Insert 1 SB15, 1 B4 and 1 SB15 through the SB11 HERE. Repeat steps 22 to 24 for three times



25) For the last position insert 1 SB11, 1 Cymbal and 1 SB11.
Reinforce.
End your thread !



26) You have finished your Flower Pearl 😊



27) All you have to do is assemble your "Isaée"© bag jewel to your liking.

For your bag jewelry assembly: 1 Lobster clasp of your choice of about 30 mm,
1 Charm of 30 mm, 15 cm of chain and some jump rings ☺
Each element can become a necklace or something else ☺

I wish you a happy beading. I offer you this pattern.
